

Frequent questions asked about International SIM Cards

Mobile phone has become an integral and indispensable part of the modern life. There is hardly a country where it is not used and there is hardly a sector of the society that does not use mobile phones. Mobile use has become routine even among the children in the age group of 10-15. However the use of mobile requires SIM cards and more often than not people involved in commercial enterprises opt for international SIM card.

International SIM Card – what it means?

SIM is the abbreviated form of Subscriber Identity Module. The tiny encoded circuit board that is inserted in the GSM cell phones is often referred to as SIM card. Though tiny in size it holds a lot of information like the subscriber's details, security data as well as the memories to store phone numbers or other information. It helps the service provider identify the caller. The advantage with the SIM card is that it can be put in any compatible GSM handset while the user is permitted to have the same number he was using in his or her earlier set.

The principle is same for SIM Cards everywhere throughout the world like in case of UK SIM Card, China SIM Card or France SIM Card you use. Apart from the GSM cellular phones, SIM Card is also required for Cingular, Nextel, Boost, AT &T, Virgin Mobile, T-Mobile, Cellular One and such other carriers. An exception is Verizon that runs on CDMA technology. An International SIM Card is usable across the globe without any restrictions relating to platform.

SIM Card use –

Many people who use SIM Card may not know the proper use of the same. They have to take help of the roadside mechanic or some other persons for the purpose. To insert the SIM in your mobile you have to remove the battery door and then find out the square slot where the SIM is placed. While inserting you should ensure that the gold metallic side of the SIM card touches the metallic part inside the slot.

Switching SIM cards is an easy process. The chip can be taken out easily and inserted in another compatible handset. You need not buy new SIM card for changing your handset. However there are some SIM cards that are dedicated to branded phones. For example Boost SIM Card will only work on Boost Cell Phones. The reason is that most of the companies lock their phones to become compatible with a particular type of SIM card. Sometimes they are also zone specific and a UK SIM Card may not work well in China.

Activation SIM Card –

Ordinarily the SIM cards do not come with any prepaid minutes or activation numbers. Only wireless SIM cards carry such facilities. The "Global System for Mobile Communications" called GSM in brief happens to be the most widely used mobile network and its use requires a SIM Card. Some of the International SIM Cards will provide you access to any of the countries and GSM phones there while some other are area specific like the France SIM Card.
