

The Convenience of Poultry Electric Netting Kits

Poultry Electric netting kits are very easy to install and provide you with all the protection you need for your chickens, turkeys, ducks, peacocks or other smaller livestock.

If you are tired of losing your poultry to the sneaky fox, badger, or tired of the neighbor's dog stressing out your chickens, which causes them to lay fewer eggs, it is time to invest in electric fencing. This way the next time the dog wants to come into your yard and chase the chicken he will get a big surprise. All he will be able to do is stand on the other side of the fence and howl from the jolt he received from your electric fencing for chickens.

The good news is you can purchase a poultry net kit that anyone can install. This means you do not have any expensive tools or other equipment. Everything you need including simple instructions will be provided in the electric poultry kit.

The most popular battery electric netting kit in the UK is the 12V battery poultry electric netting starter kit, which can also be run from mains if you desire. This is one of the best electric poultry fencing kits on the market today providing you with the ability to protect your poultry and keeping them in a certain area at the same time.

The poultry electric netting is the green flexinet electric fencing nets which comes with a Forcefield BM140 12V battery fence energiser including all leads, and a 1m earth stake. The netting also comes with 15 posts, 12 horizontal wires with 11 conductors. The netting itself begins with spacings between the wiring at 5cm near the ground and increasing upward to 20cm at the top of the electric netting.

If one net that is long enough for 105cm is not enough, the good news is that with this netting kit you receive a 12V battery fence energiser that has enough power for 7 nets. However, if you prefer to use mains, you can use the cable adapter instead of a battery energiser.

The electric fence kits include the Forcefield BM140 energiser, 50m green flexinet poultry electric netting, 1m earth stake, small tester, and a warning sign.

It is always best after you have the electric fencing for chickens installed, is to test to ensure all is in working order. The instructions found in the kit will guide you through the process so you will be finished in no time and be ready to enjoy a peaceful evening without the worry of the neighbor's dog or the sly fox pestering your poultry.
